ELECTRIC BODYWARMER

If you are susceptible to the cold, or are riding long distances – and even the most effective thermal protection will eventually let you down purely because you are physically inactive, and cooler blood from your extremities is circulated through your main torso – you can always plug in yourself and a passenger into your bike's wiring harness – it has a very low power usage – and keep yourself warm on a thermostat.



The £139 Chilli Heated Waistcoat will warm that recirculating blood, feeding it back to your extremities – and your brain – which will keep them warmer too, and the low voltage heating elements are sandwiched between thermal layers to distribute the heat evenly, avoiding unpleasant hot spots. It's also fully machine washable and waterproof. And if you're worried about electricity and water being incompatible, it is worth noting that they are sold for use on boats and snowmobiles too. It goes without saying that they also produce gloves.
